Sadiq School's Pre-K JR and Pre-K provides educational excellence to our three and four-year-old children. We strive to make intellectual leaders of tomorrow. Our competitive academic curriculum prepares Preschoolers for Kindergarten, fosters a safe and exciting learning environment and provides hands-on educational experiences through STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts and mathematics) based activities. Pre-K JR & Pre-K students at Sadiq School learn age appropriate Math, Science, P.E., Language Arts, Vocabulary and Social Skills through fun filled thematic units. Students are also exposed to memorization of the Holy Quran and Arabic Language.

A typical day in our Pre-K JR & Pre-K classroom includes a combination of the following activities:

- Circle Time, Brain warm up and starting the day activities
- Mathematic lesson hand on activities, associated worksheet.
- English Letter and Vocabulary
- A cognitive game to practice essential skills such as letter ID, letter sounds, colors, shapes, and number identification. We also worked on patterns, rhyming, and memory games.
- Story Time and comprehension analysis and lessons derived from the story.
- Specials (Library, Art, Islamic Poetry)
- Islamic Education program (Arabic, Quran, Islamic Studies)

- Small/large group activities
- Indoor play and physical education
- Social Studies/Science (Twice a week)
- Technology (once a week)
- Field trip outdoors once a month, Religious ceremonies and rituals inside the Masjid.
- Snack/Lunch/ Prayer/ Nap time on a daily basis

A Typical week for the virtual classes will be as follows:

- Circle Time/Calendar/weather
- Mathematics lesson and worksheet
- English Letter and Vocabulary, English Language Art/Reading
- Islamic Education program
- Interactive activities among students and teacher
- Educational physical education-daily
- Social Studies/Science (Twice a week)
- Quran memorization and Arabic Alphabet -once a week
